



DRESS REGULATIONS ROYAL HOBART GOLF CLUB (COURSE)

These dress regulations apply to all members, members' guests and other golfing visitors whilst on the course, when utilising practice facilities and in the clubhouse. Members are responsible for the dress and conduct of their guests. Any person failing to observe these regulations will be asked to leave the course and/or clubhouse. At all times the judgement of the General Manager, the Professional (or his staff) or the Chief Steward will be final.

Dress Standards: Consistent with the standards of the Club, smart casual attire is required at all times whilst on Club property.

Acceptable Dress

Men: Tailored slacks or shorts are required. Denim not accepted. Shirts must have a collar and unless otherwise designed, must be tucked in. The wearing of dark/coloured socks is not permitted.

Women: Modern, comfortable and functional apparel, with modesty and suitability and at the same time displaying style and modern flair suitable for the game of golf, to be accepted. Singlets and sun tops are not permitted.

Unacceptable Dress - Men and Women

Denim clothing, track pants, leisure suits, shorts or pants with drawstrings, shorts or pants with cargo-style pockets, brief shorts, shirts with messages or cartoons. Gym shoes, tennis shoes or runners.

In the clubhouse - The Dress Code in all areas of the clubhouse is smart casual attire. Men and women are required to wear smart casual shoes. Men are not permitted to wear t-shirts, sandals or scuffs and must wear socks with shoes. Lady members and visitors are requested to use fashion discretion in the clubhouse at all times. Golf shoes are not allowed except in the designated Fairway Bar and Bistro.
